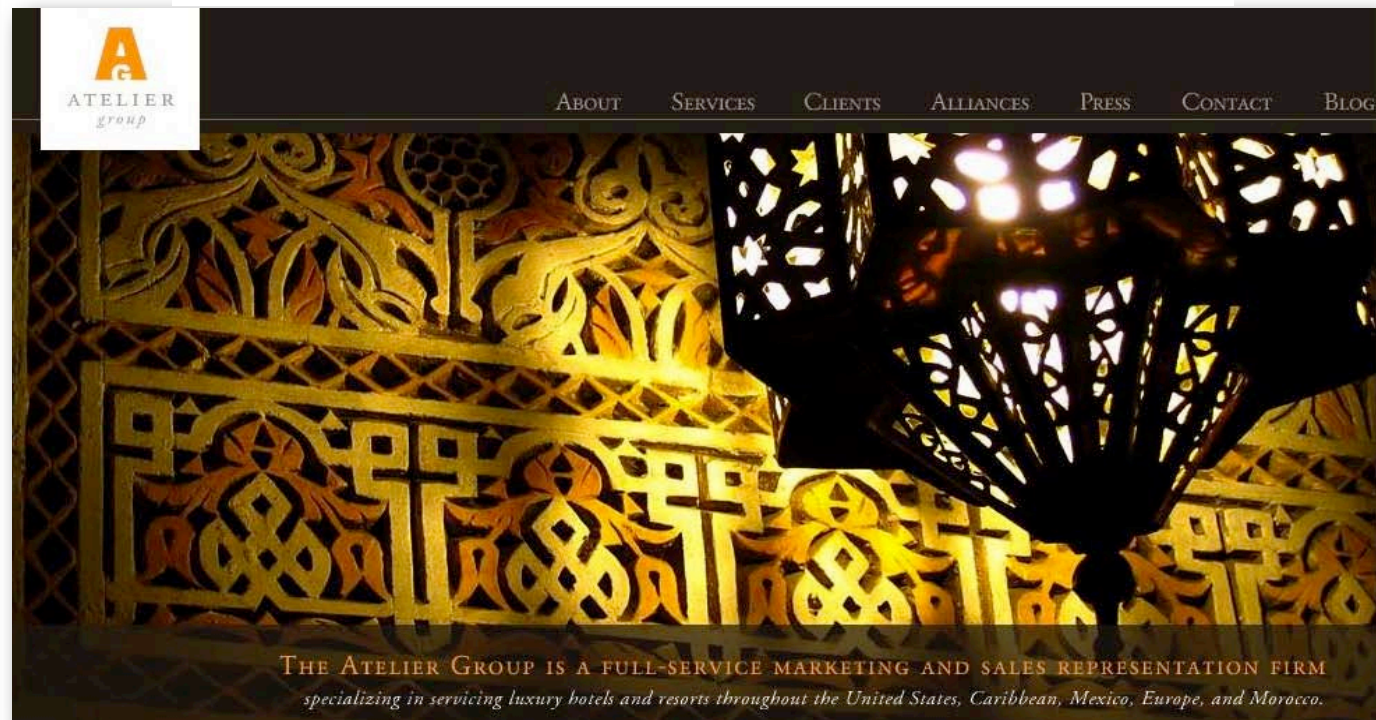

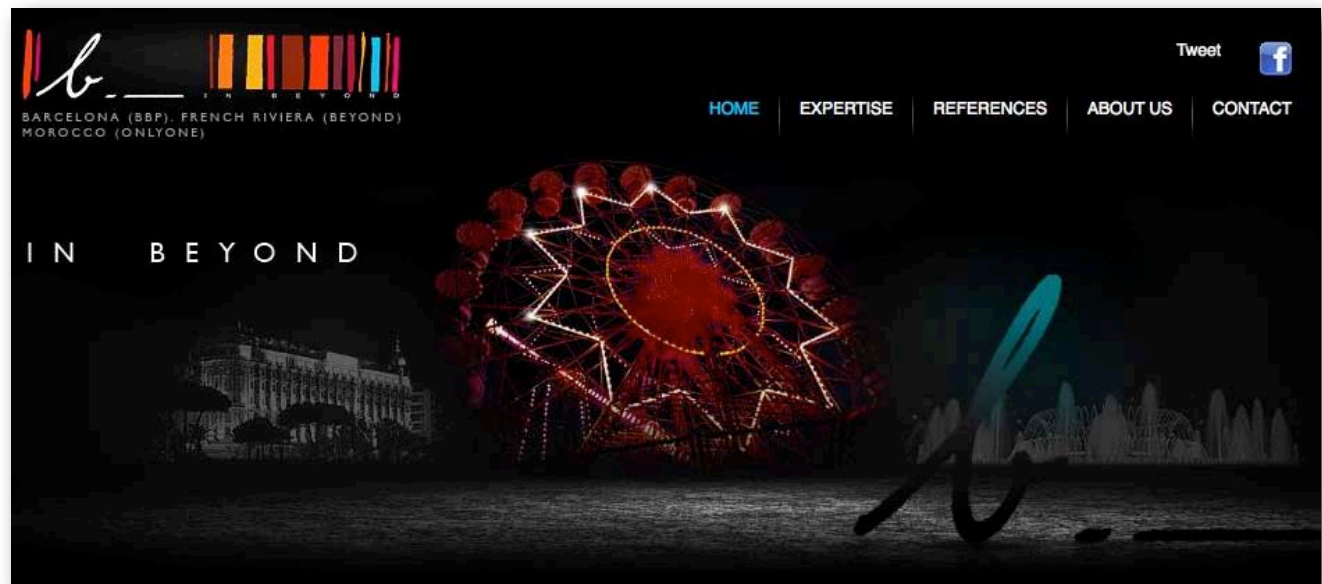

Located in the heart of the Marais in the 8th arrondissement, the Hotel Pavillon des Lettres, a charming new property looks out on the Grand Palais and is steps away from the famous Champs Elysees. Each guest room is named after a famous author, ranging from Anderson to Zola. My huge corner room was named after the French author Rousseau, and behind my bed scribed on the wall in gold leaf was the word, "Reverie". Each room has a quote about dreaming or sleeping penned by the author, and a book of their work on the bedside table. A flat screen t.v., mini-bar stocked with tasty treats and drinks, and sumptuous bath products add to the mood and detail of the room.

Aurelie Herbreht, the Sales Manager, gave me a tour of the delightful hotel and explained about the renovation of the property, which was done with great attention to detail - a marriage of old world Paris outside your door and an interior comprised of upscale new modern rooms with chrome and marble baths to relax in after a day of living like a Parisian. The Hotel Pavillon des Lettres is a twenty-six room hotel, offering two suites with fresh flowers daily and balconies. From one of the top floor suites, enjoy your pain au chocolat and morning tea on your balcony with a view of the Eiffel Tower and the City of Lights.

Specials are offered all time, and rooms may include breakfast (which is yummy and includes eggs, croissants, bacon, fruit, cheeses, tea, coffee and more), or a champagne cocktail hour. This is a new boutique hotel gem, steps away from shopping and yet perfect for a business trip or a honeymoon!



Pavillon Des Lettres is a brand new boutique hotel located in the 8th Arrondissement in Paris. Its location is ideal for visitors being that is just a few blocks away from the Champs Elysees, the Grand Palais, and high-end shopping.

There is a strong literary theme throughout the hotel. There are 26 rooms in this unique hotel, one room for each letter of the alphabet. Each room is named for a famous author. There is a book from the author in each of the rooms on the nightstand which guests are welcome to take home as a souvenir. There is also a quote or words on the walls of the room that have to do with sleeping or dreams.
