



Situated only an hour away from Los Angeles, and serenely nestled into the hills of Ojai, is the beautiful 220 acre Ojai Valley Inn and Spa. This Spanish-Colonial inspired property was built in 1923 and boasts a world-class golf course, a thirty-one thousand square foot Moroccan style spa, an Artist's Cottage, two swimming pools, four restaurants, and mind and body wellness classes. Cars are not permitted to drive on the grounds, so put on your walking shoes or hop on a bicycle and enjoy the peace and fresh Ojai air while you traverse the property.

The spa experience is wonderful. I highly recommend the Kuyam treatment which I was able to enjoy during my visit. This treatment takes place in a Moroccan steam room, (same sex only), where you are given different muds to rub on your body to help with soreness or to move toxins out of the body. After rubbing the mud on your body (you are given a terry towel initially, but the treatment is in the buff), you sit back and breathe in the steam from the center of the room, while sweating out the toxicity in your body. At the same time, a Native American meditation is played to help you focus your mind and connect with your body. An attendant comes in a few times to check on you and to give cool refreshing towels for your face, and drinking water. After the treatment, you walk through a cold spritz shower to loosen the mud, and then you shower off the mud in your private shower room. Once you are clean you then sit out on the deck and relax while you are given a detox tea. The experience is heavenly and a great idea for bridal showers, bachelorette parties, or just to do alone.

While you are visiting the Inn, take a meal at their restaurant, Maravilla. The dining experience is sensational with great service, a sommelier who really knows his wines and can recommend any pairing for your meal. I thoroughly enjoyed the beef short ribs and a great pinot noir, and I would go back there and eat it every night if I could! And of course, take your drink out on the deck while you watch the "pink moment" and toast to how wonderful it is to be enjoying the Ojai Valley Inn and Spa!


