

The Resort at Pelican Hill is a five-star resort in Newport Beach with a worldclass, 36-hole, golf course. The design definitely has Italian/Mediterranean influences so that you feel like you are vacationing in an Italian village.

There are 204 bungalows and 128 villas with private entrances. We were lucky to stay in a four bedroom villa. Each bedroom (two upstairs and two downstairs) had its own private bathroom. In addition, there was a well stocked kitchen, dining room, living room and amazing patio with stunning views. On-call butler service is a very nice touch. We had lovely, leisurely day lounging at the Coliseum Pool – apparently the largest circular pool in the world. Our deluxe cabana came equipped with a flatscreen TV and mini bar.
